Midwife

We also have a midwife who visits the surgery once a week, if you have any worries or problems she is here to help and to keep a check on you and baby throughout your pregnancy.

### **Minor Operations**

Our Doctor's also perform Minor Operations, these include the removal of Moles, skin tags. These are very minor operations, can be done with a local Anaesthetic, and usually need a couple of stitches.
